All photos should be postcard size and should preferably display the date when they were taken. The entries should be accompanied by a suitable caption. There is no registration fee for this competition

All interested are requested to register with the undersigned before 1 August 2010. The closing date for competition entries is 31 August 2010. All participants would be provided with a certificate of participation. While the three category winners of the competition will be awarded trophies. A panel of judges assigned by DG PINSTECH will short-list the entries. All entries will be displayed during the course of the seminar proceedings.
